CALL FOR NOMINATIONS

CAARP is seeking applications or nominations for two, one-year term advisory board appointments

The Center for African American Research and Policy (CAARP) was created in 2005, and is the research arm of the Brothers of the Academy Institute (BOTA). Its mission is to engage in scholarly research in order to advance critical discourse and promote informed decisions as it pertains to policy issues confronting African Americans in both the academy and the society at-large. The breadth and depth of research and policy-oriented projects encompasses the full tapestry of the "African American Predicament" and reflects the wide diversity of academic backgrounds of the affiliated researchers at the Center and BOTA members.

If you are selected for either of the advisory positions, your term will begin September 1, 2005 and will end September 1, 2006. Upon completion of your term, if your duties were performed satisfactorily, you may be recommended to serve an additional term. The initial evaluation for this process will be conducted by the Center's staff and will go through final approval with the BOTA president. As part of your duties as a Board Member, you are expected to:

- Remain in good standing (e.g., dues payment) with your membership organization (i.e., BOTA and SOTA).
- Help to provide intellectual direction to the research agenda for CAARP.
- Serve as an external reviewer of publications that emanates from CAARP.
- Serve on the editorial board of the *Annuals of the Next Generation*.
- Assist in any other CAARP activities deemed appropriate by the Center's staff based on your individual expertise.
